MESSAGE TO GRASS-ROOTS LEADERS

We are the four State Representatives who formed the New House Republican Caucus (NHRC). You deserve to know what we believe, why we did this, and what we hope to accomplish.

PRINCIPLES: We will fight for: constitutional rights, public integrity, an open and transparent legislative process that can be understood and overseen by ordinary citizens and all legislators, frugality and fiscal responsibility for public dollars, the defense of the powerless from any public or private predators.

<u>WE WILL SUPPORT ENDORSED CANDIDATES:</u> During the past two election cycles under the old Republican Caucus leadership, we saw caucus staff, resources and affiliated campaign committees work <u>against</u> party-endorsed candidates. This divisive behavior must stop! We proposed a rule change last November to only support endorsed candidates, and this was overwhelmingly rejected by the old House Republican Caucus.

WE WERE TIRED OF EXPLOSIVE SPENDING AND BACKROOM DEALS: During the past two budget cycles under the old Republican Caucus leadership, we saw state government spending explode by twice the rate of inflation. That spending exploded because, under the old Republican leaders, the "Go along to get along" style of the negotiators left fiscal conservatives without a shot.

<u>WE WERE TIRED OF MISMANAGEMENT:</u> The old Republican Caucus leadership just got fined \$15,000 and ordered to fund ruinous independent audits for the HRCC because they could not provide accurate HRCC reports of receipts, expenditures, and financial data for each of the past six years.

<u>WE WERE TIRED OF ANIMOSITY TO THE REPUBLICAN BASE:</u> For years, the old Republican caucus leadership and some staff closed their doors to a variety of groups and activists who share our values, beliefs, and commitment. Those snubbed included crowds of advocates for liberty, life, guns, small businesses, and health reform.

<u>WE WERE TIRED OF LOSING:</u> In the past, old Republican caucus leaders did not offer voters a clear choice. We have lost 24 of the last 25 state-wide elections since 2002. We cannot win until House Republicans stand up and give voters a reason to vote for us.

<u>THE ENEMY IS AT THE GATES:</u> The Democrats presented their top ten legislative goals. We four conservatives showed up and warned that <u>"the Democrats are coming for our freedom, our money, our guns, and our children."</u> Republicans have the right ideas. We will be your voice in the House.
